

Instruction to Authors for Abstract Preparation

All abstracts must be written in English and should be submitted in PDF file to scf2@kumamoto-u.ac.jp as attachment. Each abstract should be no more than one page on A4 size paper (297x210 mm; 11.7x8.3 inch) including text, tables, figures, photos, captions and references. The paper margin should be 25 mm at the top, bottom, left and right sides.

Title of the abstract should be written in Times New Roman, bold, 12 pt and centered. Initial letters of each word should be capitalized. **Author's name** should be written in Times New Roman, 12 pt, centered, **one double-space** below the title. The speaker's or poster presenter's name must be in underlined. **Affiliation** should be written in Times New Roman, 12 pt, centered, **one-semi-double-space** below the authors, in order of institution, mail address with postal/zip code and country, phone and fax numbers, and email address. **Single-spaced** is used if the length is more than a single line. Initial letters of each word must be capitalized. If there are several authors or affiliations, related numbers should be given using superscripts. **Abstract text** should be written in Times New Roman, 12 pt, justified, **double-space** below the last line of headings. Text should be started in single-spaced with ca. 1 cm (or ca. 0.25 inch) indentation at the beginning of each paragraph and no blank line between paragraphs.

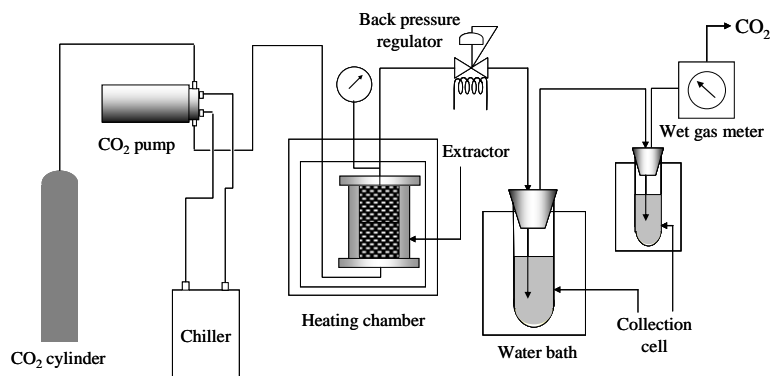


Figure 1. Schematic diagram of supercritical CO₂ apparatus

Figures and tables should be referred to in the text as "Figure 1" or "Table 1," with the proper numbering. All figures should contain proper labeling and showing clear images. All figures and tables should be directly inserted into the file and be accompanied by a caption, starting with "Figure 1: " as the example shown below.
